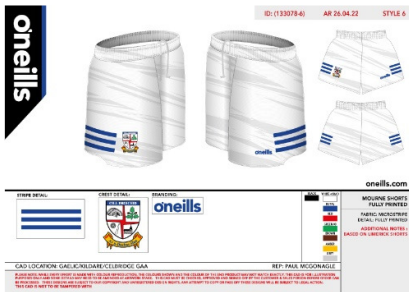


The Celbridge GAA Playing Gear Policy adheres to Rule 1.18 of the Official GAA Guide and the rules governing branding from the Camogie and LGFA Associations.

- The Celbridge home kit is a blue jersey with white trim. Male teams wear white shorts with blue trim. LGFA teams wear navy shorts with white trim. Camogie teams wear white skort (no official supplier but must have camogie crest as per association rules). Blue socks with white trim. The alternate colour jersey is red with black trim, black shorts with red trim and red socks with black trim. Camogie wear white skort.
 - GAA and LGFA goalkeepers wear the reverse colour way to the outfield jersey and camogie goalkeeper wears same colour as outfield.



- The official Celbridge GAA Club jersey and shorts are manufactured and supplied by **O’Neills**. No other clothing manufacturer is permitted to produce and supply the official Celbridge GAA Club jersey and shorts.
- The relevant association crest will be required for all team sets of jerseys used in competitions (u12 and above)
 - The Camogie & LGFA dual crest can also be used
- All jerseys – team sets and replica – will display our “aon chlub amháin” logo under the back collar.



- Should an LGFA team qualify for a provincial or All Ireland final of a title sponsored competition, the “aon chlub amháin” logo will need to be replaced with the sponsor logo, as per LGFA rules.

- The official Celbridge GAA replica home and alternate jerseys, including goalkeeper's jerseys, are available to purchase **only** from our approved retail partner SportMaster. These will only carry the main club sponsor and the GAA logo.
- For teams in Go Games leagues – u11 and below – sets of jerseys with a sponsor name (other than the main club sponsor) are permitted as a numbered set only.
- The official Celbridge GAA match day home, alternate and LGFA shorts are available to purchase **only** from our approved retail partner SportMaster.
- Teams wishing to order sets of jerseys should do so initially via the club secretary. Secretary.celbridge.kildare@gaa.ie.
- Approval from the gear committee/executive must be obtained before a sponsor logo can appear on a Celbridge GAA Jersey.
- The size and positioning of sponsor logos on jerseys are governed by the rules of the Camogie, GAA and LGFA associations.
- All jersey CAD's must be approved by the Gear Committee / executive and the sponsor before production.
- Only adult teams are permitted to use sleeve sponsor(s) and the social teams – Dads & Lads, Elites, Mothers & Others, All Stars are permitted to use their official logo.
- In addition to the club jersey, there will be a club training jersey released periodically. This will not have a sponsor / slogan displayed
- Please be aware that for any team jersey order - shortfalls will not be met by the club. It is the responsibility of the team point to contact to ensure sufficient funds are in place before ordering.
- Any breaches of the policy will be dealt with by the Executive Committee.
 - Penalty as per rule 1.18: Any unit or team in breach of this Rule shall be liable to disqualification and/or loss of expenses, and an individual(s) to a suspension of not less than twenty four weeks or to expulsion.
